

(2) Brief analysis of performance

- (a) During the financial year the performance of the Company has been almost unchanged and the gross revenue from business has increased by 02.91 % whereas the total expenses have increased by 04.22 %. This has resulted in decrease of profits after tax by around 32%:



- (b) The expenses on employees benefits is to a large extent governed by the external factors like statutory requirements and market conditions yet the management was able to control the same and the total expenses on employees benefits was reduced by 07.30% even when the total revenue witnessed an increase.
- (c) One of the Major contributors to the total cost is expenses incurred on operations. The operational cost has increased 04.68% has adversely affected the gross profit margin.
- (d) The tax burden for the year has decreased substantially by 49.30%. The decrease in tax burden is more than the decrease in net profits before tax. This is mainly because of the deferred tax assets adjustments and prior period items.
- (e) All the above factors have contributed to a aggregate decrease in the Profit after tax substantially by around 32%.
- (f) The Board of the Company is putting vigorous efforts to enhance the capacities and capabilities of the Company and is confident of improving the performance in time to come.
